Overview:

Step 1: Choose a topic from Chapters 1 – 7. This can be a great opportunity to study, so choosing a topic you already feel confident in might not be the best strategy!

Step 2: Get a free Kahoot account, if you do not have one already.

- 1) Go to www.getkahoot.com
- 2) Click on GET MY FREE ACCOUNT
- 3) Follow the prompts to create your account.
- 4) Play around with the website to get comfortable with.

Step 3: Start building your Kahoot. Your quiz will consist of practice questions for the topic chosen by you. Refer to your textbook, the Internet, and classwork assignments if you need some sample questions.

Step 4: Present your Kahoot to someone else to see if it is working well.

Step 5: Send me the link or share of your Kahoot with me. (Don't copy the URL from the editing page. I won't be able to open it with that link.)

- Your Kahoot must be at least 10 questions.
- Your Kahoot should have accurate grammar and spelling.
- Your correct answer must be correct. ☺
