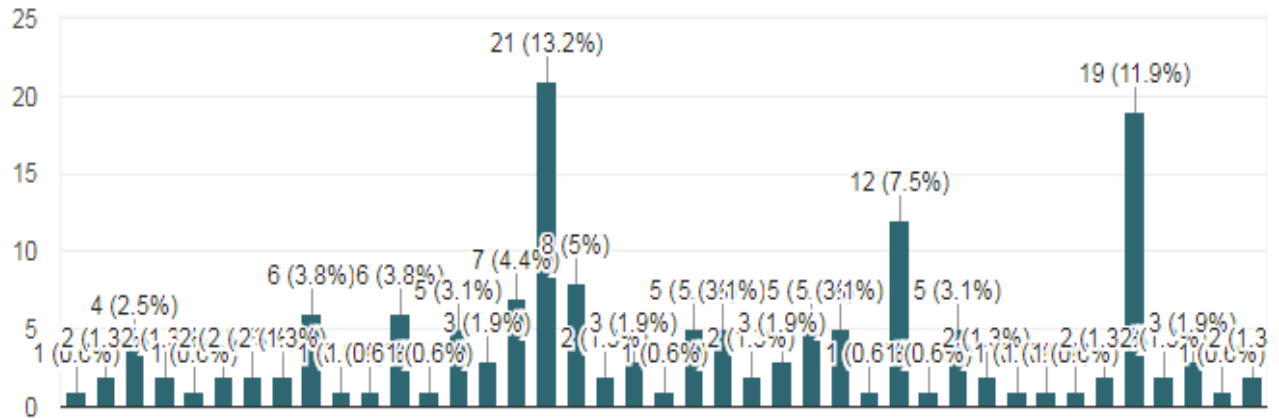


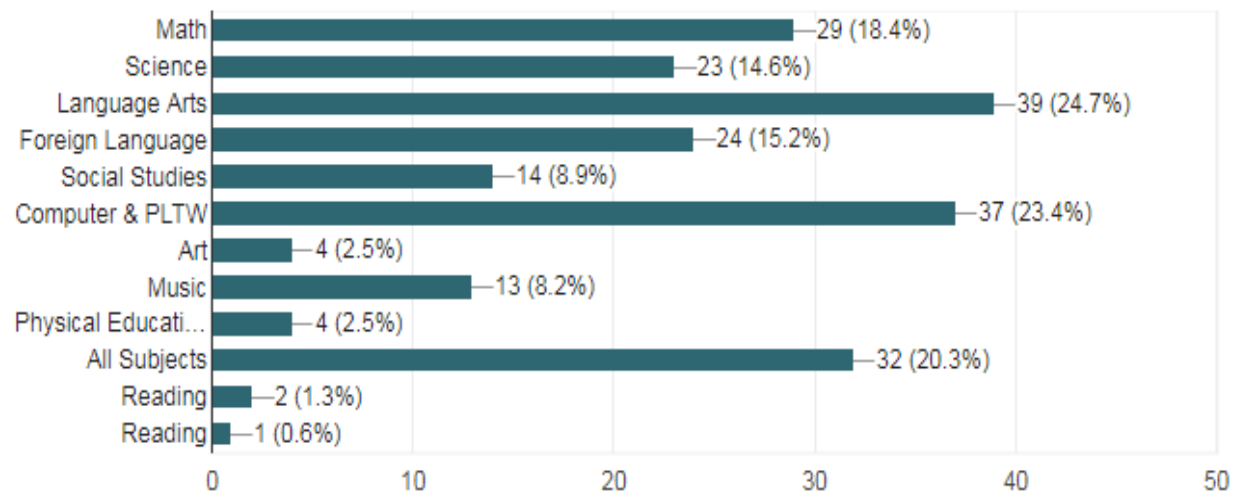

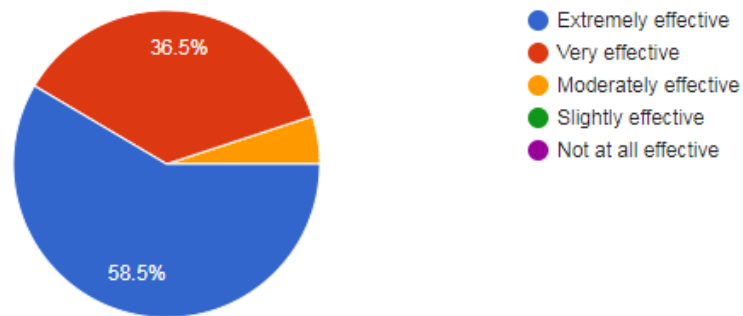

we use Schoology, Kahoot, Quizlet, rockalingua, polly lingua, Soundtouch App, Flash2Spanish App, Genius App. (2)

Students are using a 'webquest' created by me to research different animals and their habitats. Together, we are creating a class nonfiction reference book all about animals and their habitats. Students use the iPads and Computers to complete their research.

Students use AR to take comprehension quizzes over the books they are reading. This is part of their monthly reading reflections project.

Students in grades 4th-8th grade frequently use ipads to research art concepts, find reference images and examples, and occasionally to use drawing apps to experiment with non-traditional forms of art making.

Students watch videos and then they complete quizzes about whatever skill/concept we are covering. The video portion is not being done by the students, but the students are reading and answering the questions on the 'quiz' portion of each lesson.
