



Hike-A-Thon!

You will be designing a hiking trail for a four-day Hike-a-thon. The trail is 6.0 km and is in the GA Mountains. The committee has decided what kind of informational markers and stations are needed and how often they should be placed. Your task is to figure out where to put informational markers and stations along the way. After checking your calculations with the teacher, you will design a trail map.

- A Camping area and Food Wagons should be at each fourth of the trail.
- Resting Points should be at every eighth of the trail.
- Water Stations should be at every tenth of the trail.
- Juice and Snack Tables should be at every fifth of the trail.
- Kilometer Markers should be placed along the trail, so that hikers know how much of the course they've completed. These markers should be placed at every twelfth of the trail.
- Recycling Bins should be placed at every Kilometer Marker
